
Firstly, head to our homepage and click the sign up button.





Our platform is the most effective way of connecting organisations, individuals, charities, and community groups to show that by working together powerful and evidenced social impact can be created.


Get Involved

After clicking proceed to next step you will be taken to step 2, fill in your charity details here, then click create account.




Sign Up as Individual

Sign up for your free account; where you can earn Community Credits 100% of your giving is passed on to your chosen good cause.




Create Good Cause/Charities

Sign up for your free account; to engage with businesses and individuals to gain the support you need for your chosen projects in terms of volunteering, gifting items, cash donations and fundraising.




Create Business Account

After creating your account you will see this page:




Please go to your personal email where your activation link has been sent and then follow steps 1 and 2. If it isn't in your inbox, please check your spam folder.

Step 1 - Please click the link to activate your account.


Step 2 - After successful account activation please go back to the email and log on where it says: "here" to access your personal profile.

Messages - If you send messages to charity projects you're interested in you can keep up to date with them all here.


Groups - Can be created by companies or individuals, they can be private or public, whilst you can be invited to join groups you are also welcome to make your own group free of charge.

Projects - You can add personal projects here if you're fundraising yourself.

Wallet - This is where you upload money into your wallet to donate.

Settings - This is where you change your account settings such as picture, address etc.

Charity Profile.



Dashboard - This is where you will see your donations/volunteering offers, you can accept or reject offers here.

Projects - This is where your charity will post about projects you need funds/volunteers for.

Messages - People interested in volunteering/donating etc with your charity will message you here for more information.


Funds - This is where you can see how much has been raised.

Admins - This is where you will see your admins for your charity account, you can choose as many as you would like but we recommend 3 so things don't get complicated.

Settings - This is where you change your account settings such as picture, address etc.

Adding Projects.


To create projects from your charity profile, ensure you have selected your charity profile from the top right, then click projects from the options, then click create project.



To create a project, fill out all the details that are shown, you should then save the project as draft.

We recommend going over it again before publishing just to ensure all details are correct as once your project is published you can't change it! After you have done this, click publish, your project will be shown on the IIC projects page and we will push it out through social media.

We recommend you also share out on your social media!
